Recruitment

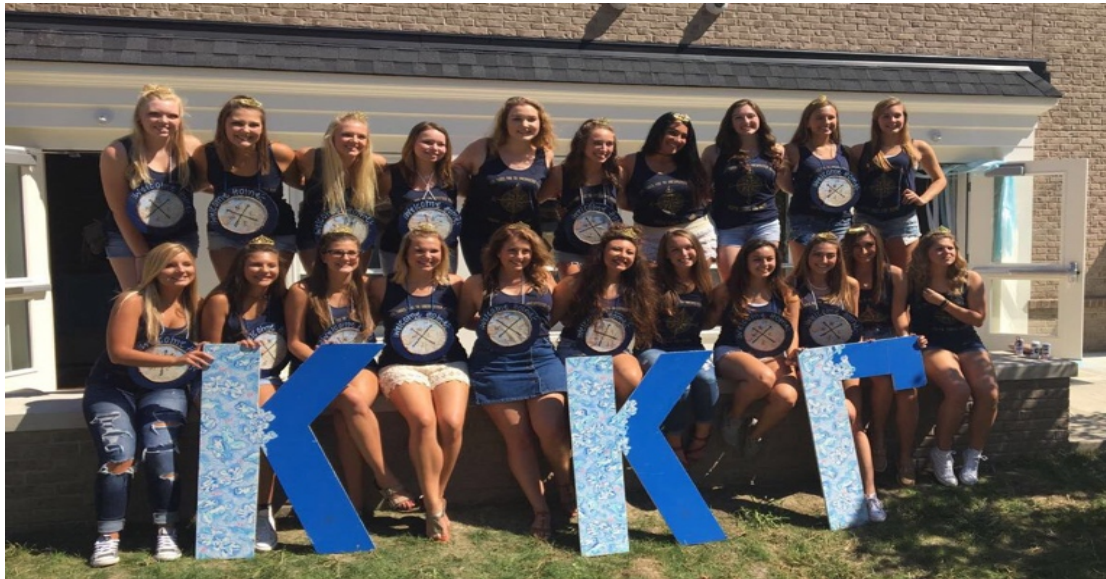

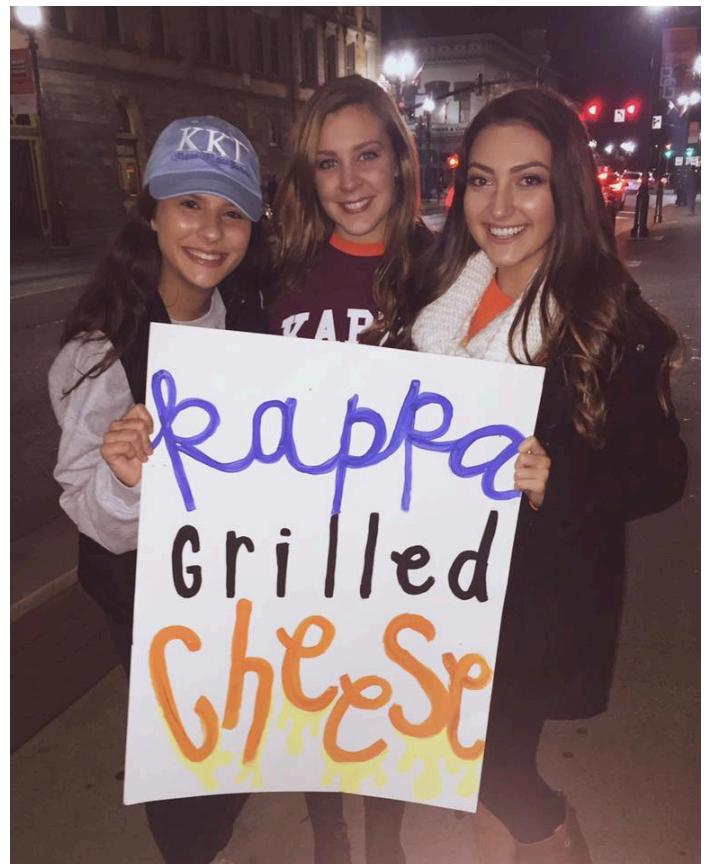


Fall Pledge Class of 2016 Bid day
